



The Tap & Vine Team are already in the habit of deep cleaning our dining areas and kitchen multiple times per day. We're also taking common sense measures like not working sick and practicing social distancing outside of work. Here a couple of extra steps you may notice that we are taking to keep you safe:

- **Focusing on keeping your visit contact free.** We're minimizing the number of team members and interactions that you experience throughout your meal while maintaining our excellent customer service.
- **Washing our hands after every interaction with a guest and regularly disinfecting all contact surfaces** We also have multiple hand washing and sanitizing stations available to all staff as well as guests.

In the interest of all our safety, we ask that you:

- **Make a Reservation.** Of course, we will do our best to accommodate you if you're feeling spontaneous and decide to just walk in. But making a reservation not only guarantees that you get that great spot out on the patio during the rush, it also lets us have everything ready to get you seated quickly.
- **Provide us with contact information.** We're doing everything we can to keep all our guests and staff safe, but in the unlikely event that we do experience a confirmed case of Covid-19 during your visit, we're required to let you know. When you arrive, we will ask all members of your party to provide their name, and phone number or email address. We'll have lots to share regarding special events and items. Please tell us if you want to be on the list for notifications. Otherwise be assured that we won't contact you unless we need to.
- **Sanitize your hands before we seat you.** We will direct you to the sanitizer when you arrive.
- **Limit your time in the restaurant.** We're incredibly grateful and happy that you've chosen to dine with us. While we will allow a bit more time in the restaurant for larger groups, understand that for parties of 4 or less, we will only reserve the table for 1.5 hours.
- **Wear a mask when not at your table.** We require that you wear a mask to spend time with us. The absolute safest option is to have one on unless you're eating.
- **Maintain social distancing when moving about the restaurant.** All our tables are at least 6 feet apart so when you're seated, you're golden. We understand that there may be times during your visit that you need to leave the table. Please be mindful of the space and do not crowd fellow diners or gather in common areas.
- **Not move or combine tables.** We get it. Your four-person reservation just became six. Your intimate dinner for two just got unexpectedly crashed by the kids. We are happy to accommodate groups of up to ten but may need to relocate your party in order to adhere to social distancing requirements. Just let us know and we'll work it out for you.
